

Amendment to the Rules of Casino Table Games – Division 8 Roulette

Pursuant to section 367 of the Gambling Act 2003 the following amendments to Division 8 of the Rules of Casino Table Games (Roulette) were prescribed on 2 November 2012.

These amendments take effect from the day after notification in the New Zealand Gazette.

Division 8 - Roulette

- 1. Rule 3.1A(b) is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "(b) 2 specific adjoining numbers or "Split", which shall:
 - (i) win if either of those numbers is spun,
 - (ii) otherwise lose, and
 - (iii) for the avoidance of doubt, the line between the courtesy '00' and '0' shall be treated as a split;"
- 2. Rule 3.6 is amended by inserting ", or the ball has dropped," after the phrase "No more bets".
- 3. Rule 3.6A is added:
 - "3.6A For the avoidance of doubt, all wagers placed after the ball has dropped shall be void."
